

Milan Wildcat Football Jamboree

Dear Participants:

This is an informational letter that will be broken down into various categories. If you have any questions, feel free to contact Mr. Tyler Clark or Coach John Dabney.

Finances:

- 1) The cost of admittance will be \$4.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students. No passes will be honored except for administrators and their spouses/coaches' spouses. Seniors 65+ will be admitted free.
- 2) Only Cheerleaders in uniforms will be admitted free.
- 3) **SPECTATORS THAT PLAN TO ATTEND BOTH THE SOFTBALL AND FOOTBALL JAMBOREE MAY PURCHASE TICKETS AT THE SOFTBALL FIELD FOR \$6.00 (FOR ADULTS) AND \$4.00 (FOR STUDENTS) TO ATTEND BOTH EVENTS.**

Scrimmage Setup:

- 1) The scrimmage will be under the control of officials from MSHSAA and all rules and regulations set down by this organization will be enforced as they would be in any regular season contest.
- 2) Each team is to bring their own balls and provide for individuals to take care of them during the scrimmage.
- 3) The host team will provide an announcer and a 40 second clock operator, but there will be no running clock or scores displayed.
- 4) There will be no kicking during the game so the ball will be placed on the twenty yard line and play will start from there.
- 5) Each team will get 18 offensive plays per quarter.
- 6) The host team will provide a chain crew for down and distance. First downs will be awarded and the ball will be moved forward and backwards, but when the team's 18 plays are up their offensive part of that quarter is complete.
- 7) If a team scores a touchdown the ball will then be placed back on the nearest twenty yard line and play will continue
- 8) At the end of each offensive play the 40 second clock will begin. The coaches will be on the field, but there will not be any delays tolerated and the officials will penalize a team if they exceed the 40 second clock. Some leniency in this rule will be tolerated for such things as equipment problems, injuries, and substitutions. There will also be added time after scores for water breaks per the new NFHS Guidelines.
- 9) Teams will be able to film during the jamboree. Arrangements will be made for each team to have a place to film from.
- 10) There will be one team assigned to each sideline per quarter and this is where teams can set up their sidelines for first aid equipment and water. Putnam Co. will move sidelines after their quarter vs. Princeton is completed.
- 11) Please keep players with cleats off the track and bleachers.
- 12) While teams are not competing, the coaches can move them to other areas behind the end zones.
- 13) Teams colors for this jamboree will be as follows:

Milan – Green

Putnam County – Blue

Princeton-White

14) The order in which the teams will compete against each other is as follows:

1st Quarter	Milan	vs	Princeton
2nd Quarter	Putnam County	vs	Princeton
3rd Quarter	Milan	vs	Putnam County

15) Locker room assignments:

Putnam County –North Locker Room (Visitors) AND South Locker Room (Milan JH Locker Room)

Princeton – Middle of North Hall (Visiting Boys Basketball) and GBB Locker Room (*If Needed*)

16) Sideline assignments – each team will have their own sideline during their game to allow for distancing.

Teams should congregate beyond the goal post south of the end zone when not playing. CLEATS SHOULD NOT BE WORN ON THE UNCOVERED PARTS OF THE TRACK.

Milan -W sideline

Putnam County -W and E sideline

Princeton- E sideline

We encourage you to remind your respective teams and fans this is just a scrimmage to test ourselves before the regular season begins. All good sportsmanship and proper behavior from fans, coaches, and players will be expected. We wish each team the best of luck this season and if you have any questions please contact me.

FAN INSTRUCTIONS

Parking: There will be gravel parking available to the North of the new gym and on the street areas surrounding the school.

Gate: Fans should keep spaced out as they wait in line at either Gate Entrance to pay Admission. The cost of admission will be \$4.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students. No passes will be honored except for administrators and their spouses/coaches' spouses. Seniors 65+ will be admitted free. **SPECTATORS THAT PLAN TO ATTEND BOTH THE SOFTBALL AND FOOTBALL JAMBOREE MAY PURCHASE TICKETS AT THE SOFTBALL FIELD FOR \$6.00 (FOR ADULTS) AND \$4.00 (FOR STUDENTS) TO ATTEND BOTH EVENTS.**

Bleachers: There will be 3 large sectioned off bleacher areas for Milan, Princeton and Putnam Co. Fans. There will be an empty space between each school's section.

Hill Areas: On each side of bleachers, the grass hill areas will be available for those that want to social distance. Fans that would like to sit there need to bring their own chairs and/or blankets.

Handicapped Parking Near The Field: There will be a few spots of handicapped parking available closer to the field for those that arrive before 6:15 PM.

Concessions: Full Concession Stand Items will be available for purchase. Spots will be marked to help with spacing out the waiting lines.

Masks/Screening At Home: Masks are optional, but recommended. Spectators SHOULD NOT attend if they have a temperature of 100.4 or higher. They also SHOULD NOT attend if currently showing symptoms or have been in close contact with someone confirmed positive of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

Health Department: All Activities hosted by Milan C-2 Schools are in cooperation with the Sullivan County Health Department and subject to change. If any school or team has any COVID-19 information to share in the interest of public health, please contact Milan C-2 School District or the Sullivan County Health Department.
