

Services

A home cooked hot lunch is served from 11:30-1:00. Buffet is offered on Friday and Salad bar is offered with the meal on Wednesday and Friday. There is a choice of the traditional meal or a delicious Chef or Cobb salad and fruit. Meals on Wheels is offered to the home bound seniors with the optional Saturday and Sunday frozen meals. Suggested donation is \$3.50 per meal for those 60 and over. For those under 60, the cost is \$6.50.

An Aging Resource Center (located at the P.C. Café) is also available with two qualified staff to assist seniors and their care givers with Medicare and Medicaid, Social Security and specialize with Part D comparisons. The center is the place to find resources and information. The center offers free monthly health screening and nutrition information along with educational materials.

PUTNAM COUNTY ATTRACTIONS

PUTNAM COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM

201 S. 16th Street 947-2955

The Putnam County Historical Society Museum was named "Best Small Town Museum" by the Rural Missourian magazine in 2013. The museum houses many interesting and unique displays, including artifacts, tools and dishes from the past. You will find on display a beautiful hand painted Limoges punch bowl, a horse-drawn hearse, a large weaver's loom, rope beds, lovely antique furniture, quilts, dolls, coal mining tools and memorabilia. As Putnam County was the home to the first Schaeffer Pen Company and Putnam Fadeless Dyes, the museum has memorabilia to share with all who visit. The museum also has a collection of items from the Continental Airlines Flight 11 crash that occurred on May 22, 1962 in Putnam County. The historical society has recently published a book set of the History of Putnam County that is offered for sale at the museum along with other books of history written by individuals and cemetery books produced by the Putnam County Genealogical Society. Please plan an afternoon to step back in time at the Museum.

Hours: 10-4 Tuesday all year and 1 to 4 Friday and Saturday from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Also open by appointment.

UNIONVILLE CITY PARK 615 North 22nd Street

The Unionville City Park is a source of pride for the entire community. Facilities include several shelter houses, playground equipment and community pool and a basketball court. The park has recently been updated with a concrete walking trail that is 10 feet wide and can accommodate walkers, runners, bicycles and wheelchairs. The renovated park also has new playground equipment. Also on the grounds is the Cub Scout Building that is available to the public for social events. You can step back in time when you visit the "Little Red School House" located by the Scout building. The school house was originally used as a country school then moved to town and used at the local elementary school until being moved to the park. Appointments can be made with Unionville City Hall for viewing.

Also located at the park is the R.V. Campgrounds with 68 hook-ups with most including water, electric, sewer and cable television. Restroom facilities are available on grounds. As the park is the home of the Putnam County Fair, many other facilities are on the grounds and available to the public for events. We hope you come and enjoy our park grounds.

UNIONVILLE COMMUNITY POOL

Unionville City Park 947-SWIM (7946)

The Unionville Community Pool was built in 2015 and features a zero-entry area with fun splash zone for younger children. In the splash zone area, you will find an umbrella swing, spray area, climbing area with slide and spray features. The older children and adults will enjoy the lazy river that features float tubes for a lazy river ride or choose to walk the river for exercise. The SplashTacular Water Slide is fun for all ages with an exciting twisting tube area. The deepest end of the pool is 12 feet in depth and swimmers can lap swim, use the diving board or climb on the rock wall. A concession stand is available and the pool can be rented for private parties. Swimming lessons, special events, water workout classes, lazy river walks and adult only swim times are available throughout the summer.

LAKE MAHONEY/CITY OF UNIONVILLE RESERVOIR Reservoir Trail

Lake Mahoney is the water reservoir for the City of Unionville located approximately one mile north on State Highway 5 and 3 miles west on Reservoir Trail. Lake Mahoney is an excellent place to visit for fishing and wildlife watching. The lake has a boat ramp for small fishing boats.

Lake Thunderhead, a private 1500 acre recreational lake located 3 miles North of Unionville, is a wonderful attribute to our county. There are numerous homes constructed on over 900 lots developed along the 34-mile shoreline along with 22 condominiums and 4 townhomes. The lake is 7 miles long and offers many recreational opportunities such as water sports, swimming, golfing, tennis, camping and fishing. Two swimming beaches and campgrounds are available as well as a nine-hole sand green golf course and two tennis courts.

Although hunting is not allowed on lake property, residents can enjoy numerous species of wildlife and birds in their natural habitat. Bald eagles, wild turkey, ducks and geese as well as pheasant, quail and whitetail deer are abundant. Property owners and guests enjoy fishing the professionally stocked lake. Several fishing tournaments are sponsored annually.

MINERAL HILLS STATE FOREST

4 miles southeast of Unionville (off state highway F)

Mature forests provide serene areas to enjoy trees and woodland wildflowers. Watch for ring-necked pheasant, bobwhite quail, wild turkeys, cottontail rabbits, squirrels and white-tailed deer. Hunting, fishing and horseback riding are permitted. Primitive camping on walk-in basis.

PRAIRIE TRAIL/ALL WEATHER TRACK

Located on the PC R1 School grounds

The Prairie Trail is a .6 of a mile walking trail with half of the trail being wheelchair accessible. Trail walkers can enjoy the nature as well as the incline of a few small hills. Enter at the parking lot south of the softball fields. The trail is lit from 5 a.m. to dawn and dusk to 9 p.m.

The All Weather Track located around the football field offers walkers and runners a premium surface. The track is open weather permitting and lit from 5 a.m. to dawn and dusk to 9 p.m.. Enter at the track entrance east of the high school and review the track rules at the entrance.

PUTNAM COUNTY COURTHOUSE & SQUARE 1601 Main Street, Unionville

Located at the center of the Unionville square

The Putnam County Courthouse was built in 1924 and is on the National Historic Register along with the majority of buildings on the town square. On the courthouse lawn are several displays of historical significance. The Historic Trees Living Heritage Museum was established in 1989 by the Putnam County Historical Society. The historic trees are identified with markers adjacent to the trees included in the museum. The Putnam County Veterans Memorial is located on the Northwest corner of the lawn. The Continental Flight 11 Memorial is located on the Northeast corner of the courthouse lawn. It is a memorial for victims of a plane that crashed in Putnam County in 1962 as a result of a suicide bombing. The courthouse lawn also displays a marker with information on the history of Putnam County.

REBEL'S COVE WILDLIFE AREA

Located in extreme northeast Putnam County (on Route N)

This stretch of land owned by the Missouri Conservation Department on the Chariton River is one of the few unchanged, unchanneled parts of the river. The cove has some outstanding wetland habitat. The winding channel has created many oxbow lakes and marshes that attract Canada geese, muskrat, beaver and river otters. Native wildlife is abundant and river otters have been reintroduced here. In the summer you may visit a great blue heron rookery, and in the winter months it is not uncommon to see a bald eagle floating overhead or perched in a treetop overlooking the river. Hunting, fishing, hiking and camping is permitted in designated areas.

UNIONVILLE COUNTRY CLUB 307 8th Street 947-3100

The Unionville Country Club offers a 9 Hole Golf Course that was expanded and updated to grass greens in 2005. There is also a clubhouse which provides drinks and snack foods as well as social activities. Contact the club for membership rates and green fees.

PUTNAM COUNTY EVENTS

LUCERNE STOCK SHOW

The Lucerne Stock Show has been held annually since 1939. The show is held in August at the Lucerne Park located 15 miles west of Unionville off of Highway 136. The event features livestock shows, talent contest, 4 Wheeler Races, senior Olympics, kids games and a kiddie parade, food stand and exhibits including 4-H, crafts, needlework, quilts, woodworking, flowers and vegetables.

PUTNAM COUNTY FAIR

The Putnam County Fair is one of the largest county fairs in the area. It is held annually at the Unionville City Park from Tuesday through Saturday following Labor Day. A season ticket will allow gate admission to let you enjoy all exhibits, shows and entertainment including performances by nationally known music artists. Exhibits include baked goods, 4-H projects, crafts, needlework, quilts, woodworking, flowers, vegetables, art, livestock, poultry and rabbits by area youth and adults. Events include lawn mower, tractor and ATV pulls, livestock shows, baby show, 4-H royalty, fair queen contest, bull buckout, pro tractor pull, demonstrations, kid's games, commercial booths and a carnival. A food stand is available for meals on the grounds. Camping facilities are available.

ALL SCHOOL ALUMNI REUNION

This annual event is held the Saturday and Sunday before Labor Day. All graduates of Unionville and Putnam County schools are invited to attend. A catered luncheon is held on Saturday at the Putnam County School Complex with entertainment following the luncheon.

Sunday begins with coffee & donuts in the commons. A business meeting and memorials are held with a catered luncheon following. All classes holding reunions that year are encouraged to schedule their reunion during this time.

MARTINSTOWN MUSIC FESTIVAL AND VENDOR FAIR

This annual event is held the first Saturday in August at the renovated Martinstown Schoolhouse. A meal is provided with musical entertainment. Local vendors provide an opportunity for shopping during the event.

LIVONIA SCHOOL REUNION

The Livonia School Reunion is held on the second Saturday in June every two years. All alumni are welcome to attend the event and enjoy socializing with classmates, enjoying a meal and reminiscing with stories and pictures.

LUCERNE SCHOOL REUNION

The Lucerne School Reunion is held each year on the Sunday prior to Father's Day in June. The event is held at the 4-H building on the Lucerne fairgrounds and is near the site of the original schoolhouse. All alumni of the Lucerne school are welcome to attend the event that includes a carry-in luncheon and meeting. For more information, call 660-793-3352.

COUNTRY & OLD TIME MUSIC FESTIVAL

Old time country and bluegrass music is played at the Unionville City Park on the second weekend in June each year. Musicians and spectators from at least half a dozen states converge at the park beginning with the Thursday evening gospel music and continuing through Saturday evening with an open stage. Food is served on the grounds. No admission is charged but donations to defray expenses are appreciated. Camping, modern restrooms and showers are available on the park grounds.

INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

Unionville's 4th of July Celebration is supported by many civic organizations, businesses and local individuals. The event includes a parade around the square and evening fireworks provided by community donations are spectacular! Fireworks may also be viewed by the public at Lake Thunderhead where the show is generally held on the Saturday before or after the 4th of July.

HOLIDAY LIGHTING CEREMONY

A holiday lighting ceremony is held the Saturday before Thanksgiving every year in the Putnam County Courthouse in Unionville. Santa Claus arrives to help count down to the turning on of the holiday lights around town. The Keynotes, a local singing group leads the singing of Christmas carols and cookies, coffee and punch are served. Santa Claus is available to visit with the children and for picture-taking opportunities.

DOWNTOWN WINTERFEST

This annual event takes place on the square the first Saturday in December. A meal is provided by the P.C. Café on the west side of the square in the evening. The public is invited to stroll the square viewing the store windows where organization and business members pose depicting the scenes of the great Norman Rockwell, Christmas movie themes and religious themes. A Holiday Lighted Parade of vehicles is included in the evening festivities along with musical entertainment, train rides, visits with Santa, a Living Nativity Scene and events at the museum and other locations around the downtown area. The public can also enjoy the sounds of the Keynotes as they perform Christmas carols, the high school brass section and the Methodist Church Bell Choir.

CRAFT & COLLECTIBLE FAIR

The Craft & Collectible Fair is held annually on the last Saturday in October from 9-3 at the Unionville City park buildings. The fair hosts a variety of vendors including jewelry, sewing and wood crafts, home and holiday decorations and food items. There is no charge for entry and homemade food is available for purchase during the noon hour.

MARKET ON THE SQUARE

The Market on the Square is held each Saturday from May thru October from 7 - 11 a.m. on Unionville's historic downtown area. The market offers a variety of vendors including farmers market fresh food items, jewelry, crafts, clothing to name a few. The market is open each week so the variety of vendors and items offered for sale changes with the seasons. There are multiple events each month with special market themes, unique items, displays and entertainment.


